
Competition Classes

Pom


High energy, sharp, and detailed movements with poms.

CLASS PLACEMENT

Level Placement

We provide general age guidelines for each class, but ultimately, level placement is determined by technical skill, coordination and overall ability. Students should sign up for their age class and if a teacher feels they are in the wrong class level, OPDC will contact you about a schedule change. **Ages are of January 1st, 2025.**

Acro dancers are evaluated the year before and their placement recommendations will show up on your Parent Portal. You may also e-mail to ask. New Acro dancers wishing to register for non beginner classes should contact the studio to schedule a placement evaluation.

Students should expect to spend a few years in each level before advancing. Teachers are always available to offer additional feedback and support to help students achieve their dance goals.

Placement decisions are based on many years of teaching experience. We place each child in the group or class where we believe they will feel confident enough to develop self-esteem. Some students might become discouraged if placed in a higher level before they are ready, potentially losing their passion for dance. Placement is highly individual, and the factors involved in these decisions are complex.

TUITION

Monthly Tuition

Tuition is based off the dance season and broken into 10 equal payments, no matter the amount of times seen in a month. August - May are full payments regardless of how many lessons are attended in a month. Our season consists of a minimum of 33 weekly classes, one on stage rehearsal, and one recital day. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday classes have two days worked in for weather cancellations or teacher sickness cancellations that will not require make up days, Thursday classes have one day worked in. Make up days will be offered for any classes cancelled by OPDC past the built in days.

Payments

All payments are non-refundable. Cash, credit card, or check is accepted. We require every account to have a method of payment on file through the Parent Portal. Parents are responsible for updating if there are changes. All fees will be auto-drafted on their due dates.

Credit Cards incur a 3% fee. We do not accept payments over the phone. Returned checks will incur a \$25 fee. A late fee of \$10 per fee is added to any payment past 5 days late.

Account Balances

OPDC sends an automated e-mail to accounts with a balance on the 10th of each month. Students with a past due balance will not be allowed to participate in class. Students may be dropped from classes after a past due balance is more than 30 days late. A registration fee will be required to sign up again.

30 Minute Class: \$50/monthly

45 Minute Class: \$55/monthly

1 Hour Class: \$60/monthly

We are not responsbile for splitting payments between family members of split families. All communication and payments are the responsibility of the person who registered the dancer.

RECITAL FEE: \$50/STUDENT OR \$70/FAMILY WITH STUDENTS IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD.

PAYMENT IS NON REFUNDABLE AND DUE APRIL 15TH. FEE INCLUDES TWO TICKETS PER FAMILY, ONE PAIR OF TIGHTS PER STUDENT, AND ONE RECITAL AWARD PER STUDENT.

STUDIO POLICIES

Refund Policy

All payments are non-refundable.

Photo/Video Release

Photos and videos of students may be used for marketing and promotional purposes. By enrolling your child, you consent to the use of their images.

Code of Conduct

Students are expected to show respect to instructors and peers at all times. This includes listening attentively, following instructions, and maintaining a positive attitude. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary actions. Parents should support a positive environment by encouraging their child and respecting the studio policies. Any concerns or issues should be addressed privately with studio staff/director.

Health and Safety Guidelines

Students should stay home if they are feeling unwell, especially if they have symptoms of contagious illnesses. Please inform the studio if your child will be absent due to illness. All injuries must be reported to the studio office immediately. An incident report will be completed and parents will be notified if an injury takes place in class. In case of serious injury, emergency medical services will be contacted.

Withdrawal Policy

To withdrawal from a class, please notify the office in writing by e-mail or filling out a withdrawal form in person. This must be done by the 25th of the month prior that you wish to be dropped. If after the 25th, a \$25 drop fee will be charged to the card or bank account on file.

Dress Code Enforcement

Students must adhere to the dress code at all times. Non-compliance may result in being asked to sit out of class until proper attire is worn.

Class Observations

Only students enrolled in a class can be in the classroom. All classes (except Dancer & Me) are done independently. We have viewing doors at every classroom entrance for anyone wishing to observe.

Studio Rules

Students younger than 9 years old must be accompanied in and out of the studio and if they have class breaks. Students must not be dropped off more than 5-10 minutes before class. Students should be picked up no later than 5 minutes after class ends. Listening ears, inside voices, and hands to yourself should be used in the facility at all times . No hanging on ballet barres, furniture, or any other structures. **NO GUM** allowed in the facility. Do not bring valuables, we are not responsible for lost or stolen items. No running in common areas. Keep all areas clean, please pick up after yourself. Anyone in the waiting areas should be waiting quietly.

Food/Drink Policy

Bottled water only in dance rooms and locker rooms. Any snacks or meals should be consumed ONLY in the Cafe. If using the microwave and the fridge please clean up any messes made. Do not leave items in the fridge overnight, all items will be thrown away if left. If the cafe becomes a problem with food or trash (or any other area in the studio) we may shut down the cafe for the season and not allow food/drink in the facility.
